

GOVERNMENT NOTICE

**MEDICINES AND RELATED SUBSTANCES ACT, (ACT NO. 101 OF 1965)
(ANNUAL ADJUSTMENT OF THE SINGLE EXIT PRICE OF MEDICINES AND
SCHEDULED SUBSTANCES FOR THE YEAR 2013)**

I, Dr A MOTSOALEDI, the Minister of Health, have determined on recommendation of the Pricing Committee, in terms of Regulation 8(1) of the Regulations Relating to a Transparent Pricing System for Medicines and Scheduled Substances published under the Medicines and Related Substances Act. (Act 101 of 1965) as amended, that the Single Exit Price (SEP) of Medicines and Scheduled Substances may only be applied for from 02 January 2013 to 30 September 2013 to a maximum of 5.8% of the Single Exit Price schedule that was last published on 21 December 2012.

An adjustment in the Single Exit Price in terms of this Notice may only be implemented by the manufacturer or importer of the relevant medicine or scheduled substance, 30 working days after the date that the manufacturer or importer has communicated the information requested by the Director-General in terms of the Notice published under Regulation 21 of the Regulations Relating to a Transparent Pricing System for Medicines and Scheduled substances.
