

MEDICINES AND RELATED SUBSTANCES ACT, 1965

REGULATIONS RELATING TO A TRANSPARENT PRICING SYSTEM FOR MEDICINES AND SCHEDULED SUBSTANCES: AMENDMENT (SINGLE EXIT PRICE ADJUSTMENT FOR THE YEAR 2011)

I, Dr A Motsoaledi, the Minister of Health has on the recommendation of the Pricing Committee, in terms of Regulation 8 (1) of the Regulations Relating to a Transparent Pricing System for Medicines and Scheduled Substances as published in Government Gazette 28214 of 11 November 2005, that the Single Exit Price as defined in the said Regulations as it prevailed on 30 November 2010 may not be increased from the 02 January 2011 until 31 December 2011, unless an increase is made in terms of Regulation 9 of the said regulations.
